Welcome to the iPod nano Take-Apart manual. Nanos are small and fragile, so you have to handle them with care. The inside is pretty much one piece including the logic board, battery (which is soldered on), RAM (2 or 4GB), headphone jack, and data port. There is one slight difference between the design of the 2GB and 4GB models.

It's easiest to identify the 4th gen. iPod nano based on what it doesn't have, rather than what it does. Since the 4th and 5th gen. models look so similar, the key way to tell them apart is to look for the video camera

lens on the backside. If there's no lens, you've got the 4th generation nano.
