While the bulk of the ground fighting took place in the Russian Crimean Peninsula (from whence the war's name originates), combat also occurred in the Ottoman-controlled Balkans, along the Russian-Ottoman Caucasus border region, in the Russian Far East, and naval combat took place in the Baltic Sea, the Black Sea, and the western Pacific Ocean region.
